## Charitable Health Care Clinics - Volunteer Physicians - Medical Malpractice Insurance

This bill requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) to study legal and policy issues regarding the use of volunteer physicians at charitable health care clinics in Maryland. The report must include an assessment of the potential cost of State funding for volunteer physicians' medical malpractice premiums. DHMH must submit a report by January 1, 2000 to the Governor and General Assembly with any recommendations for legislative or other action. The bill takes effect June 1, 1999.
