House Bill 1127 (Delegate Clagett. *et al.*) Commerce and Government Matters

Education - School Buses - Safety Reports

This bill requires the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) to submit a report on school bus safety to the General Assembly by December 31 of each year. The report must include information on the number of students injured on school buses, school bus capacity and overcrowded conditions, and the number of days that public school buses were used to transport students to the public schools. Local boards of education must collect and provide MSDE with any information required by the report.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1999.
