House Bill 468 (Delegate Arnick) Commerce and Government Matters

Vehicle Laws - Shuttle Permits

This bill provides that motor vehicle registration is not required for new vehicles being operated as part of a shuttle, while following a registered vehicle displaying a shuttle permit issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration. The bill defines "shuttle" as a procession of new vehicles being moved between a maritime port facility and a temporary storage area that is not more than five miles distant. Under current law, registration is not required if each vehicle displays a shuttle permit and is moved between a maritime port facility and a temporary storage that is not more than three miles distant.

State Effect: Negligible. The bill would apply in only a limited number of cases.
