Emergency Vehicle Privileges - Use of Audible Signal

This bill allows an emergency vehicle to exercise emergency vehicle privileges while parking or standing without the use of an audible signal. Current law requires that the emergency vehicle use both an audible and visual signal in order to exercise such privileges.
