AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 110

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after "Force;" insert "requiring certain law enforcement agencies to provide certain information to the Task Force under certain circumstances;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 2, lines 3 and 4, line 9, and line 12, in each instance, strike "Stops for Routine Traffic Violations" and substitute "Race-Based Traffic Stops".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, in line 13, strike "15" and substitute "17"; in line 27, strike the second "and".

On page 2, in line 3, after "Governor" insert ";

(9) One member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House; and

(10) One member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 2, after line 28, insert:

"(g) A law enforcement agency defined under Article 27, § 727(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland may provide, to the extent practicable and to the extent not in conflict with any laws of the State, information described under subsection (f) of this section to the Task Force, provided that the information may not contain any information that may reveal the identity of any individual who is stopped or any law enforcement officer."

(Over)

in line 29, strike “(g)” and substitute “(h)”; and in line 32, strike “(h)” and substitute “(i)”.

On page 3, strike “(i)” and substitute “(j)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 2, in line 29, after “for” insert “:

(1)”;

in line 31, strike the period and substitute “; and”; and after line 31, insert:

“(2) developing any recommendations from the Task Force which encourage law enforcement agencies to adopt policies against race-based traffic stops to be used as management tools to promote nondiscriminatory law enforcement and in the training and counseling of law enforcement officers.”.
