AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO. 802 (Third Reading File Bill)

On page 2, strike beginning with "<u>THE</u>" in line 27 down through "<u>BUDGET.</u>" in line 29 and substitute:

"(1) <u>THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET</u> <u>BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2002, AT A MINIMUM, SUFFICIENT FUNDS TO</u> <u>OPERATE, MANAGE, AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM AS REQUIRED BY THIS</u> <u>SUBSECTION.</u>

(2) THE FUNDING INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET SHALL BE AT

LEAST:

(I) <u>\$2.2 MILLION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002; AND</u>

(II) <u>\$1.2 MILLION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 AND EACH</u> SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR.

(3) <u>FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM MAY BE PROVIDED THROUGH THE</u> <u>CIGARETTE RESTITUTION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-317 OF THE STATE</u> <u>FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.</u>".
