AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 103

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Middleton, Kasemeyer" and substitute "<u>Kasemeyer</u>, <u>Middleton</u>"; in the same line, strike "and Green" and substitute "<u>Green, Currie, and Stone</u>"; in line 2, strike "Weeks" and substitute "<u>Week</u>"; and in line 6, after "week;" insert "<u>submitting a certain report</u> by a certain date;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 20, strike "AUGUST 11, 2000" and substitute "AUGUST 10, 2001"; and in the same line, strike "AUGUST 17, 2000" and substitute "AUGUST 16, 2001".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, after line 27, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Comptroller shall assess the impact of this Act based on the best information available to the Comptroller and information derived from a survey of a sample of retailers that file sales and use tax returns electronically. Subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the Comptroller shall report its findings to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2001."

On page 2, in line 1, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
