AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 199

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Privacy" insert "Policies"; in line 5, after "collect" insert "personal"; in line 7, after "whom" insert "personal"; in the same line after "exceptions;" insert "requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to report annually to the General Assembly on certain regulations;"; in line 9, strike "units" and substitute "each unit"; in the same line, strike "certain" and substitute "the unit's"; and in line 10, after "records;" insert "encouraging counties and municipal corporations to conform certain practices to this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 3, strike "SHALL" and substitute "MAY"; in line 4, after "ESTABLISHED" insert "BY THE UNIT COLLECTING THE RECORDS"; in line 5, strike "SHALL" and substitute "COLLECTED FOR PERSONAL RECORDS"; in line 6, after "(I)" insert "SHALL"; in line 8, after "(II)" insert "SHALL"; in line 9, strike "POSSIBLE" and substitute "PRACTICABLE"; in line 10, after "(III)" insert "MAY"; in line 13, strike "ENDEAVOR" and substitute a comma; in the same line, after "TO" insert "THE GREATEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE,"; in line 14, after "PERSON" insert "IN INTEREST"; in line 15, after "INFORMATION" insert "FOR PERSONAL RECORDS"; in line 16, after "PERSON" insert "IN INTEREST"; and in line 18, after the second "THE" insert "PERSONAL".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike beginning with "STUDENT" in line 7, down through "(V)" in line 14; and strike beginning with "(VI)" in line 17 down through "(VII)" in line 21 and substitute "(IV)"; and in line 23 after "BOARDS" insert "; AND

(V) ANY OTHER PERSONAL RECORDS EXEMPTED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, in line 19, after "That" insert "the General Assembly encourages counties and municipal corporations to review their privacy policies and data security safeguards and conform their practices to those set forth in §10-624(c) of the State Government Article as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
