- 23 (a) Any aggrieved party to a hearing may appeal from a decision or order of 24 the Administration as follows:
- 25 (1) If the matter concerns the license of [the] A party to drive and the
- 26 party is a resident of this State, to the circuit court for the county in which the party

- 1 (2) If the matter concerns any other license or privilege of [the] A party, 2 to the circuit court for the county in which the principal place of business of the party 3 in this State is located;
- 4 (3) If [the] A party is a nonresident motorist, to the circuit court for the 5 county in which the party was convicted of the violation to which the matter relates; 6 and
- 7 (4) If not otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the Maryland 8 Vehicle Law, to the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 10 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 11 on or application to any action for judicial review filed before the effective date of this
- 12 Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2000.
