- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 (a) Except for the occupant of a disabled vehicle who seeks the aid of another
- 15 vehicle, a person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or
- 16 business from the occupant of any vehicle.
- 17 (b) A person may not stand on or near a highway to solicit any other person to
- 18 watch or guard any vehicle while it is parked or about to be parked on a highway.
- 19 (C) A MINOR MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY TO SOLICIT FOR CHARITABLE
- 20 PURPOSES.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2000.
