- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM MILITARY SERVICE MAY
- 19 APPLY TO THE STATE BOARD TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IF THE
- 20 INDIVIDUAL WITHDREW FROM A REGULAR FULL-TIME PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL
- 21 ACCREDITED BY THE STATE BOARD DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S SENIOR YEAR IN
- 22 HIGH SCHOOL TO ENLIST IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES DURING
- 23 WORLD WAR II.
- 24 (B) THE STATE BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SHALL
- 25 JOINTLY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR
- 26 AWARDING DIPLOMAS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 July 1, 2000.
