3 FOR the purpose of continuing the Tobacco Authority in accordance with the

- 5 to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and
- 6 regulatory authority of the Tobacco Authority; requiring that an evaluation of
- 7 the Tobacco Authority and the statutes and regulations of the Tobacco Authority
- 8 be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the Tobacco Authority to
- 9 issue a certain report to the General Assembly containing certain information by
- 10 a certain date annually; and generally relating to the Tobacco Authority.

2 3	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8	Subject to the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, the provisions of this subtitle and of any rule or regulation relating to the Tobacco Authority under this subtitle shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2001] 2006.

19 (e) On or before November 30 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a

20 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a

21 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this 22 section.

23 (M) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION,
24 ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2005, AN EVALUATION SHALL BE MADE OF THE TOBACCO
25 AUTHORITY AND THE REGULATIONS THAT RELATE TO THE TOBACCO AUTHORITY.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 June 1, 2000.

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
