19 NONDISCIPLINARY REASONS.

21 (a) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:

18 PENSION SYSTEM TERMINATED AS A RESULT OF BEING LAID OFF FOR

22 on or before the date of retirement, the member has at least 20 years (1)23 of eligibility service;

for at least 5 years immediately before retirement, the member was a 24 (2)25 security attendant at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center, a correctional officer in any 26 of the first six job classifications, or in a combination of these positions; and

27 (3) the member completes and submits a written application to the 28 Board of Trustees stating the date when the member desires to retire.

29 (b) On retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal 30 service retirement allowance that equals one fifty-fifth of the member's average final 31 compensation multiplied by the number of years of creditable service.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 July 1, 2000.

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
