2 **Education - Public School Holidays - Presidents' Day**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing Presidents' Day as a public school holiday; and
4 generally relating to public school holidays in the State.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - Education
7 Section 7-103(c)(1)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (1999 Replacement Volume)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

2 7-103.

- 3 (c) (1) The following days are public school holidays:
- 4 (i) Thanksgiving Day and the day after;
- 5 (ii) Christmas Eve and from then through January 1;
- 6 (iii) Martin Luther King, Jr. Day;
- 7 (iv) PRESIDENTS' DAY;
- 8 (v) The Friday before Easter and from then through the Monday
9 after Easter;
- 10 [(v)] (VI) Memorial Day; and
- 11 [(vi)] (VII) Primary and general election days.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 July 1, 2000.
