- 5 hospice care from managed care coverage and to pay licensed hospice programs
- 6 directly in accordance with hospice rates set by the Department of Health and

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article - Health - General
- 16 15-103.3.
- 17 THE SECRETARY SHALL:
- EXCLUDE HOSPICE CARE FROM THE SERVICES THAT A MANAGED
- 19 CARE ORGANIZATION IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE TO ENROLLEES.
- PAY LICENSED HOSPICE PROGRAMS DIRECTLY FOR HOSPICE CARE 20 (2)
- 21 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HOSPICE RATES SET BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22
- 23 October 1, 2000.
