A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Special Education - Extending Age of Eligibility

- 3 FOR the purpose of extending the time through which a child is eligible for special
- 4 education and related services to the end of the school year in which the child
- 5 turns 21 years of age; and requiring special education and related services
- 6 regulations of the State Board of Education to cover a child through the end of
- 7 the school year in which the child turns 21 years of age.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 8-403.
- 17 (a) The State and each local school system shall make a free appropriate
- 18 public education available to each child with a disability, as provided by this subtitle.
- 19 (b) Appropriate special education and related services are available to a child
- 20 with a disability from birth through [age 20] THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR IN
- 21 WHICH THE CHILD TURNS 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- 22 8-404.
- 23 (a) The State Board shall adopt, as regulations, standards for the
- 24 identification, evaluation, educational placement, and the provision of a free
- 25 appropriate public education of each child in this State who [is under] HAS BEGUN
- 26 THE SCHOOL YEAR ON OR BEFORE the age of 21 and is found to need special
- 27 education and related services, whether or not the child is receiving nonduplicative
- 28 services from another governmental agency.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2000.
