- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 11-209.
- 16 (A) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL TO PUBLISH 17 IN ITS CATALOG ITS SCHEDULE OF TUITION AND FEES AND METHOD OF PAYMENT.
- 18 (B) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT PROHIBIT A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL FROM
- 19 OFFERING A DISCOUNTED TUITION OR FEE FOR A COURSE EVEN IF THE
- 20 DISCOUNTED AMOUNT IS DIFFERENT FROM THE SCHOOL'S PUBLISHED TUITION AND
- 21 FEES.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 2000.
