2 Vehicle Laws - Proof of Insurance - Traffic Stops

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the owner of a motor vehicle registered in the State to
- 4 maintain proof of required security in the vehicle; requiring the driver of the
- 5 vehicle to display proof of required security under certain circumstances;
- 6 providing that, in the case of certain rental vehicles, proof of required security
- 7 may be satisfied in a specified manner; providing that certain violations do not
- 8 constitute a moving violation for certain purposes; and generally relating to
- 9 verification of required security for a motor vehicle under provisions of the
- 10 Maryland Vehicle Law.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Transportation
- 24 17-101.
- 25 (b) "Required security" means security in the form and providing for the
- 26 minimum benefits required under this subtitle or any other provisions of the
- 27 Maryland Vehicle Law.

- 2 This subtitle does not apply to the following vehicles and their drivers:
- 3 (1) Farm equipment or special mobile equipment incidentally operated 4 on a highway or on other property open to the public; or
- 5 (2) A vehicle operated on a highway only to cross the highway from one 6 property to another.
- 7 17-104.1.
- 8 (A) AN OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS REGISTERED IN THIS STATE 9 SHALL MAINTAIN IN THE VEHICLE PROOF OF REQUIRED SECURITY FOR THE 10 VEHICLE.
- 11 (B) A DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS REGISTERED IN THIS STATE
- 12 SHALL DISPLAY THE PROOF OF REQUIRED SECURITY ON DEMAND OF A POLICE
- 13 OFFICER WHO SHOWS IDENTIFICATION AS A POLICE OFFICER.
- 14 (C) SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY BE SATISFIED BY
- 15 MAINTAINING IN THE VEHICLE AND MAKING AVAILABLE A VALID RENTAL
- 16 AGREEMENT THAT PROVIDES EVIDENCE OF REQUIRED SECURITY IN THE CASE OF A
- 17 RENTAL VEHICLE THAT IS RENTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 18 OF THIS
- 18 ARTICLE.
- 19 (D) FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS SECTION IS
- 20 NOT A MOVING VIOLATION FOR PURPOSES OF § 16-402 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- Whenever evidence of security is required under this subtitle, a person may not
- 23 willfully and knowingly create, certify, file, or provide false evidence of required
- 24 security.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2000.
