- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Transportation
- 19 13-809.
- 20 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 21 (2) "Fair market value" means:
- 22 (i) As to the sale of any new or used vehicle by a licensed dealer,
- 23 the total purchase price, as certified by the dealer, REDUCED BY THE AMOUNT OF ANY
- 24 REBATE PROVIDED TO THE BUYER BY THE MANUFACTURER OF THE VEHICLE;

- 1 (3) "Total purchase price" means the price of a vehicle agreed on by the 2 buyer and the seller, with no allowance for trade-in or other nonmonetary 3 consideration.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4
- 5 July 1, 2000.
