9 Section 1

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Chapter 304 of the Acts of 1998

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:

15 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 16 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery 17 County - Joseph White House Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to the 18 lesser of (i) \$200,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance 19 with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and 20 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of 21 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 22 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

(2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
§ 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

1 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable

2 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the [Board of Directors of the Parks

3 Foundation, Inc.] MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING

4 COMMISSION (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning,

5 design, repair, renovation, restoration, and capital equipping of the historic Joseph

6 White House, located in Boyds, Maryland.

7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the 11 (5)12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 13 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either 14 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 15 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds 16 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property. 17 In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets 18 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter 19 and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present 20 evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be 21 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and 22 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan 23 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided 24 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund 25 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

26 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey 27 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of 28 its interest:

29 30 the Trust; a	nd	(i)	On 25 acres of the land or such portion of the land acceptable to
31		(ii)	On the exterior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.
32	(b)	The ease	ement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust

33 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 35 October 1, 2000.

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
