1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

7	Notwithstanding any other law of this State effective on or before June 30, 1973, or any local law, the restrictions imposed by this title are the only restrictions on the political activities of an employee of a local entity, except for the restrictions [imposed on employees] THAT ARE:
9 10	(1) IMPOSED ON AN EMPLOYEE of a board of supervisors of elections by Article 33, § 2-301 of the Code; OR
11 12	(2) PROVIDED IN OR AUTHORIZED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY CHARTER AND IMPOSED ON:
