14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 (a) (1) Subject to the limitations in this section, the official custodian may

 $19\,$ charge an applicant a reasonable fee for the search for, preparation of, and

20 reproduction of a public record.

(2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS
 SECTION, THE FEE FOR REPRODUCTION OF A PUBLIC RECORD MAY NOT BE MORE
 THAN THE ACTUAL COST OF REPRODUCTION.

24 (b) The official custodian may not charge a fee for the first 2 hours that are 25 needed to search for a public record and prepare it for inspection.

22 (3) DATA, SYSTEM PRODUCTS, AND SYSTEM SERVICES ADOPTED UNDER 23 §§ 10-901 THROUGH 10-905 OF THIS TITLE.
