16 (b) On written request to the clerk of the court, the property owner is entitled

17 to receive any amount paid into the court for [his] THE PROPERTY OWNER'S benefit,

18 WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE REQUEST, without prejudice to any of [his] THE PROPERTY

19 OWNER'S rights, if [he] THE PROPERTY OWNER agrees to repay to the Commission

20 any excess of that amount over the final award that is allowed in the subsequent

21 condemnation proceedings.

23 On written request to the clerk of the court, the property owner is entitled to

24 receive any amount paid into the court for [his] THE PROPERTY OWNER'S benefit
