12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

15 2-308.

16 EACH UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING A UNIT WITH AN
17 INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM, SHALL REQUIRE EACH APPLICANT FOR
18 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE UNIT TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S HIGH
19 SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2000.
