- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Transportation
- 15 13-903.1.
- 16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED AS:
- 17 (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
- 18 (2) A CLASS D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE;
- 19 (3) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE; OR
- 20 (4) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A 1 TON OR LESS
- 21 MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY.
- 22 (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE
- 23 ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE IS \$10, PLUS THE CURRENT EMERGENCY SERVICES

- 1 (I) IS AT LEAST 70 YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION;
  2 AND
  3 (II) HAS A GROSS ANNUAL INCOME OF LESS THAN \$15,000, OR A
  4 COMBINED GROSS ANNUAL INCOME OF LESS THAN \$30,000.
  5 (2) IN THE CASE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS JOINTLY OWNED, IF ONE
  6 OR MORE OF THE OWNERS IS UNDER THE AGE OF 70 AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION:
  7 (I) THE REGISTRATION FEE SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
  8 SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE VEHICLE; AND
- 9 (II) THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR THE VEHICLE SHALL BE THE 10 REGISTRATION FEE SPECIFIED IN THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT WOULD 11 OTHERWISE APPLY TO THE VEHICLE.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2000.
