CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Libraries - Funding - Regional Resource Centers**

3 FOR the purpose of altering to certain amounts in certain fiscal years the minimum  
4 allocations per each resident of the area served that each participating regional  
5 resource center shall receive for operating and capital expenses; and generally  
6 relating to funding for the regional resource centers.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Education**

4 23-205.

5 (a) Each year, the Department may include in its budget operating funds for:

- 6 (1) The State Library Resource Center;
- 7 (2) Each regional resource center; and
- 8 (3) Each metropolitan cooperative service program.

9 (b) (1) The State shall pay all capital expenses for:

- 10 (i) The State Library Resource Center; and
  - 11 (ii) Each regional resource center.
- 12 (2) Before any money is spent under this subsection, the appropriate  
13 board of library trustees shall:

- 14 (i) Have the project approved by the Department;
- 15 (ii) Through the Department, submit the request to the  
16 Department of Budget and Management for consideration under Subtitle 6, Title 3 of  
17 the State Finance and Procurement Article; and
- 18 (iii) Agree to reimburse the Department an amount the Department  
19 determines if the facility ceases to be used for a resource center or cooperative service  
20 program.

21 (c) (1) Each year each participating regional resource center shall receive a  
22 minimum AMOUNT of [\$1.70] FUNDING for each resident of the area served, to be  
23 used for operating and capital expenses.

24 (2) THE ALLOCATION SHALL BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

25 ~~(I)~~ (I) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.....\$1.70 PER EACH RESIDENT OF THE  
26 AREA SERVED;

27 ~~(II)~~ (II) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002.....\$3.50 PER EACH RESIDENT  
28 OF THE AREA SERVED;

29 ~~(III)~~ (III) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003.....\$4.00 PER EACH RESIDENT  
30 OF THE AREA SERVED; AND

31 ~~(IV)~~ (IV) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR  
32 THEREAFTER.....\$4.50 PER EACH RESIDENT OF THE AREA SERVED.

1 (d) (1) Each year the State Library Resource Center shall receive a  
2 minimum amount of funding for each State resident in the previous fiscal year, to be  
3 used for operating and capital expenses.

4 (2) The allocation shall be calculated as follows:

5 (i) For fiscal year 2001.....\$1.35 per State resident;

6 (ii) For fiscal year 2002.....\$1.55 per State resident;

7 (iii) For fiscal year 2003.....\$1.70 per State resident; and

8 (iv) For fiscal year 2004 and each fiscal year thereafter.....\$1.85 per  
9 State resident.

10 (e) (1) The Department shall:

11 (i) Disburse funds to the State and regional resource centers and  
12 metropolitan cooperative service programs; and

13 (ii) Require that these funds be used subject to any conditions  
14 specified by the appropriating agency or imposed under this subtitle.

15 (2) The Department may authorize the State Comptroller to withhold  
16 funds from any regional resource center or metropolitan cooperative service program  
17 that fails to meet the standards adopted by the Department.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 July 1, 2000.
