CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Baltimore City Health**
3 **Department Men's Public Health Center**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
5 ~~\$300,000~~ \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Commissioner of
6 Health for Baltimore City for certain development or improvement purposes;
7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
8 the grantee provide and expend a certain matching fund; and providing
9 generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That:

12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
14 City - Baltimore City Health Department Men's Public Health Center Loan of 2000 in
15 the total principal amount of ~~\$300,000~~ \$100,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the
16 issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a
17 resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance
18 with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and
19 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Commissioner of Health for Baltimore
4 City (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design,
5 construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a primary
6 care facility for adult males, to be located in Baltimore City.

7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

11 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
13 matching fund of \$80,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
14 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
15 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property. The fund may
16 consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of this
17 Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or
18 assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the
19 matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2002, to
20 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
21 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to
22 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes
23 provided in this Act.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 June 1, 2000.
