A BILL ENTITLED

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1	AN	ACT	concerning

2 Calvert County - Agricultural Land Preservation Program - General 3 Obligation Installment Purchase Agreements

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of

- 5 Calvert County, from time to time, to enter into installment purchase
- 6 agreements for an aggregate purchase price of not more than \$10,300,000, plus
- 7 interest thereon, to acquire transfer development rights in tracts or parcels of
- 8 agricultural and forestry land located in Calvert County, Maryland as part of the
- 9 County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program; empowering the County to
- fix and determine, by resolution, the tracts or parcels of land the transfer
- development rights of which are to be acquired and the form, content, terms and
- 12 conditions of each installment purchase agreement, including, without
- limitation, the purchase price payable thereunder, the maturity date of the
- installment purchase agreement, the interest rate and the schedule of payments
- of the purchase price (or the method of determining such interest rate and
- payment schedule) and all other details incident to the acquisition of the
- development rights and the installment purchase agreements; providing that
- the County's obligation to make payments of the purchase price under the
- installment purchase agreements and to pay interest thereon shall be a general
- 20 obligation of the County made upon its full faith and credit; empowering and
- 21 directing the County to levy, impose, and collect, annually, ad valorem taxes in
- rate and amount sufficient to provide funds for the payment of the maturing
- 23 purchase price of and interest on the installment purchase agreements;
- 24 exempting the installment purchase agreements and the interest thereon and
- 25 any income derived therefrom from all State, county, municipal, and other
- 26 taxation in the State of Maryland; authorizing and empowering the County to
- 27 purchase and set aside in a segregated fund or account U.S. Treasury STRIPs or
- other investments allowed under certain provisions of the law and the
- 29 investment guidelines of Calvert County to pay the balance of the purchase
- price of the installment purchase agreements payable on their maturity dates;
- and relating generally to the County's entering into installment purchase
- 32 agreements to acquire transfer development rights in agricultural and forestry
- 33 lands in Calvert County.

34 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

35 MARYLAND, That, as used herein, the term "County" means the body politic and

- 1 corporate of the State of Maryland known as the County Commissioners of Calvert
- 2 County; and the term "Installment Purchase Agreement" means an agreement
- 3 pursuant to which the County will acquire transfer development rights in one or more
- 4 tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land located in Calvert County, Maryland
- 5 from the owners thereof, will pay the purchase price for that land either in
- 6 installments or at the maturity of the Installment Purchase Agreement and will pay
- 7 interest on the unpaid balance of that purchase price.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County is hereby
- 9 authorized and empowered to enter into Installment Purchase Agreements for an
- 10 aggregate purchase price of not more than \$10,300,000, plus interest thereon, to
- 11 acquire transfer development rights in tracts or parcels of agricultural and forestry
- 12 land located in Calvert County, Maryland as part of the County's Agricultural Land
- 13 Preservation Program. The County's obligation to make payments of the purchase
- 14 price under each Installment Purchase Agreement and to pay interest on the unpaid
- 15 balance of the purchase price under each Installment Purchase Agreement shall be a
- 16 general obligation of the County and shall be made upon its full faith and credit, and
- 17 shall be evidenced by the Installment Purchase Agreement.
- 18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County shall select
- 19 the tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land for which transfer development
- 20 rights are to be acquired and shall negotiate the purchase price for such transfer
- 21 development rights and all other terms and conditions of the Installment Purchase
- 22 Agreement with the owner or owners of such property, all in accordance with the
- 23 County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program as in effect from time to time.
- 24 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each Installment
- 25 Purchase Agreement shall be entered into in accordance with a resolution of the
- 26 County, which shall provide for the acquisition of the transfer development rights in
- 27 one or more specified particular tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry property
- 28 located in Calvert County, Maryland which is to be the subject of the Installment
- 29 Purchase Agreement. The County shall have and is hereby granted full and complete
- 30 authority and discretion in the resolution to specify the tracts or parcels of
- 31 agricultural or forestry land the transfer development rights of which are to be
- 32 acquired and to provide and approve the form, tenor and content of the Installment
- 33 Purchase Agreement described in the resolution, including, without limitation, (a) the
- 34 designation, (b) the dated date, (c) the purchase price thereunder (or the maximum
- 35 purchase price and the method of determining the final purchase price subject to such
- 36 limitation), (d) the maturity date of the Installment Purchase Agreement (not
- 37 exceeding 30 years from the date of execution and delivery of the Installment
- 38 Purchase Agreement) on which the final balance of the purchase price is payable, (e)
- 39 whether any portion of the purchase price will be payable prior to the maturity date
- 40 of the Installment Purchase Agreement, and, if so, the dates of payments of any
- 41 installments of the purchase price and the amounts of such installments (or the
- 42 methods or formula for determining such installment dates and amounts), (f) the
- 43 interest rate per annum (or the method of determining such rate) payable on, the
- 44 Installment Purchase Agreement from time to time and the dates for payment of such
- 45 interest, (g) the terms and conditions, if any, under which the Installment Purchase
- 46 Agreement may or shall be redeemed prior to its maturity date, (h) provisions relating

- 1 to the registration and transfer of the Installment Purchase Agreement, (i) the
- 2 required signatures on the Installment Purchase Agreement and all related
- 3 documents, (j) the appointment of a paying agent and registrar for the Installment
- 4 Purchase Agreement, which may be the Director of Administration and Finance of the
- 5 County, any other employee of the County, any department of the County government
- 6 or any bank or trust company within or without the State of Maryland having
- 7 corporate trust powers, (k) covenants relating to compliance with applicable
- 8 requirements of federal income tax law, including (without limitation) covenants
- 9 regarding the payment of rebate or penalties in lieu of rebated, and (1) generally all
- 10 matters incident to the acquisition of the transfer development rights and the terms,
- 11 conditions, execution and delivery of the Installment Purchase Agreement.
- Each Installment Purchase Agreement may be made redeemable before
- 13 maturity, at the option of the County, at such price or prices and under such terms
- 14 and conditions as may be fixed by the County prior to the execution and delivery of
- 15 the Installment Purchase Agreement. The Installment Purchase Agreement shall be
- 16 in registered form. In case any officer whose signature appears on any bond or on any
- 17 coupon attached thereto ceases to be such officer before the delivery thereof, such
- 18 signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes as if he or she had
- 19 remained in office until such delivery. Any Installment Purchase Agreements entered
- 20 from time to time into under the authority of this Act shall be specifically exempt
- 21 from the provisions of Sections 9, 10 and 11 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of
- 22 Maryland.
- 23 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Installment Purchase
- 24 Agreement hereby authorized shall constitute, and they shall be recite, an irrevocable
- 25 pledge of the full faith and credit and unlimited taxing power of the County to the
- 26 payment of the maturing purchase price under the Installment Purchase Agreement
- 27 and the interest thereon are paid in full, the County shall levy or cause to be levied ad
- 28 valorem taxes upon all the assessable property within the corporate limits of the
- 29 county in rate and amount sufficient, together with any recordation tax revenues
- 30 designated for such payments and other available funds, to provide for or assure the
- 31 payment, when due, of the purchase price of all outstanding Installment Purchase
- 32 Agreements and the interest thereon maturing in each such fiscal year and, in the
- 33 event the proceeds from the taxes so levied in any such fiscal year shall prove
- 34 inadequate for such payment, additional taxes shall be levied in the succeeding fiscal
- 35 year to make up any such deficiency. The County may apply to the payment of the
- 36 purchase price of the outstanding Installment Purchase Agreements and interest
- 37 payable thereon any funds received by it from the State of Maryland, the United
- 38 States of America, or any agency or instrumentality thereof, or from any other source,
- 39 if such funds are granted for the purpose of assisting the County in financing the
- 40 acquisition of transfer development rights in agricultural or forestry land located in
- 41 Calvert County, Maryland and to the extent of any such funds received or receivable
- 42 in any fiscal year, the taxes that are required to be levied may be reduced accordingly.
- 43 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County is authorized
- 44 and empowered to purchase and set aside in a segregated fund or account U.S.
- 45 Treasury STRIPs or other obligations allowed under Article 95, Section 22, 22F, and
- 46 22G of the Annotated Code of Maryland (or any successor provision of law) and the

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- 1 County's guidelines, as in effect from time to time. It is intended that investments in
- 2 that segregated fund or account will be applied to the payment of the balance of the
- 3 purchase price of the Installment Purchase Agreements on their respective maturity
- 4 dates; but the investments shall not be pledged to the payment of the purchase price
- 5 of any of the Installment Purchase Agreements or the interest thereon, and no person
- 6 other than the County shall have any interest therein.
- 7 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any and all Installment
- 8 Purchase Agreements entered into by the County pursuant to the authority of this
- 9 Act, their transfer, the interest payable thereon, and any income derived therefrom in
- 10 the hands of the registered owners thereof from time to time (including any profit
- 11 made in the sale thereof) shall be and are hereby declared to be at all times exempt
- 12 from State, county, municipal, or other taxation of every kind and nature whatsoever
- 13 within the State of Maryland.
- 14 SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the authority conferred
- 15 on the County by this Act to enter into Installment Purchase Agreements and create
- 16 debt of the County shall be deemed to provide an additional and alternative authority
- 17 for borrowing money and creating debt and shall be regarded as supplemental and
- 18 additional to powers conferred upon the County by other laws and shall not be
- 19 regarded as in derogation of any power now existing; and all Acts of the General
- 20 Assembly of Maryland heretofore passed authorizing the County to borrow money
- 21 and incur debt are hereby continued to the extent that the powers contained in those
- 22 prior Acts have not been exercised, and nothing contained in this Act may be
- 23 construed to impair, in any way, the validity of any bonds or other obligations that
- 24 may have been entered into by the County under the authority of any of said Acts, and
- 25 the validity of the bonds or other obligations is hereby ratified, confirmed, and
- 26 approved. This Act, being necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of Calvert
- 27 County, shall be liberally construed to effect the purposes hereof. All Acts and parts of
- 28 Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of
- 29 such inconsistency.
- 30 SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 June 1, 2000.
