- $17\,$ MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 3 (a) (1) The liquor control boards may establish and maintain stores to be
- 4 known as "county liquor dispensaries", for the sale of any sparkling or fortified wine
- 5 and any other alcoholic beverages containing more than 14 percent of alcohol by
- 6 volume, in sealed packages or containers. These packages or containers may not be
- 7 opened nor their contents consumed upon the premises where sold.
- 8 (E-1) IN WICOMICO COUNTY, THE COUNTY LIQUOR DISPENSARIES MAY SELL
- 9 CHILLED BEER, NONCHILLED BEER, WINE, LIQUOR, ICE, AND BOTTLED WATER.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2000.
