BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Transportation** 20 21 16-402. After the conviction of an individual for a violation of Article 27, § 388, § 22 23 388A, or § 388B of the Code, or of the vehicle laws or regulations of this State or of any 24 local authority, points shall be assessed against the individual as of the date of 25 violation and as follows:
