17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "LATE FEE" MEANS ANY CHARGE OR FEE IMPOSED 18 BECAUSE A PAYMENT IS NOT MADE WHEN THE PAYMENT IS DUE UNDER THE TERMS 19 OF A CONTRACT.
(2) "LATE FEE" INCLUDES A FEE IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 21 THIS SUBSECTION THAT IS DESCRIBED:

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to 16 contracts entered into prior to, on, or after the effective date of this Act, including all 17 contracts in effect on or after June 8, 1995.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 19 late fees provided for in contracts entered into, or in effect, on or after November 5,
20 1995. This Act does not apply to late fees imposed before November 5, 1995.
21 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2000.
