Waiver of Tuition and Fees - Foster Care Recipients

3 FOR the purpose of providing a certain waiver from tuition and mandatory fees for

4 certain students who enter an institution of higher education and who reside or

5 have resided in foster care; providing the conditions for receiving the waiver;

6 exempting a recipient from repaying certain amounts; defining certain terms;

7 providing for the duration of the waiver; requiring the Department of Human

8 Resources to provide certain information to the Maryland Higher Education

9 <u>Commission each year</u>; and generally relating to a waiver from tuition and

10 mandatory fees for certain students who reside or have resided in foster care.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 21 INDICATED.

1	(2) "FOSTER CARE RECIPIENT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
2 3	(I) RESIDED IN A FOSTER CARE HOME IN THE STATE ON OR AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL'S 18TH BIRTHDAY; OR

	(I) THE FOSTER CARE RECIPIENT IS ENROLLED AT THE INSTITUTION ON OR BEFORE THE DATE THAT THE FOSTER CARE RECIPIENT REACHES THE AGE OF 21 YEARS;
