- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (A) THERE IS A STATE DRIVER'S EDUCATION COUNCIL.
- 24 (B) THE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 17 MEMBERS:
- 25 (1) ONE MEMBER FROM THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE 26 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE:
- 27 (2) ONE MEMBER FROM THE SENATE OF MARYLAND APPOINTED BY THE 28 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE POLICE, OR THE SECRETARY'S (3) 2 DESIGNEE: THE STATE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER, OR THE COMMISSIONER'S 4 DESIGNEE; THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, OR THE (5) 6 SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE: TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ADMINISTRATION WHO HAVE 7 8 RESPONSIBILITY FOR DRIVER AND VEHICLE POLICIES AND PROGRAMS, INCLUDING 9 DRIVER'S EDUCATION AND LICENSING, DESIGNATED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR; 10 (7) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION 11 DESIGNATED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF BOARDS OF EDUCATION, OF 12 WHICH: 13 ONE SHALL BE FROM A LOCAL JURISDICTION THAT PROVIDES A (I) 14 DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, OR 15 THROUGH A PRIVATE PROVIDER; AND ONE SHALL BE FROM A LOCAL JURISDICTION THAT DOES NOT (II)17 PROVIDE A DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM; A LOCAL SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT DESIGNATED BY THE PUBLIC 18 19 SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND; A SECONDARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL DESIGNATED BY THE MARYLAND 20 21 ASSOCIATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL PRINCIPALS; 22 (10)THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE PARENT TEACHERS 23 ASSOCIATION, OR THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE: AND 24 THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS TO BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR: (11)A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE FIRE-RESCUE OR EMERGENCY 25 (I)26 MEDICAL SERVICE COMMUNITY; TWO REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE MARYLAND PROFESSIONAL 27 (II)28 DRIVER EDUCATION ASSOCIATION; AND 29 (III)TWO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC. 30 TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE. THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COUNCIL 31 SHALL BE DIVERSE WITH REGARD TO GEOGRAPHIC, RACIAL, AND GENDER 32 REPRESENTATION. 33 (D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL.

THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL IS 3 YEARS.

- 1 (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE 2 TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 1, 2000.
- 3 (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A 4 SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 5 (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES 6 ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND 7 QUALIFIES.
- 8 (F) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET REGULARLY, AT LEAST TWO TIMES 9 A YEAR, AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN.
- 10 (G) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR
- 11 SERVING ON THE COUNCIL, BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES
- $12\,$ UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE
- 13 BUDGET.
- 14 (H) THE COUNCIL SHALL:
- 15 (1) MAINTAIN OVERSIGHT OF DRIVER EDUCATION ACTIVITIES AND 16 PROGRAMS IN THE STATE;
- 17 (2) EXAMINE AND EVALUATE NECESSARY MODIFICATIONS AND
- 18 IMPROVEMENTS IN THE DRIVER EDUCATION ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE
- 19 STATE; AND
- 20 (3) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS BASED ON ITS EVALUATION
- 21 CONCERNING DRIVER EDUCATION ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE STATE.
- 22 (I) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFFING FOR THE COUNCIL.
- 23 (J) THE COUNCIL SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE
- 24 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
- 25 ARTICLE, ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial
- 27 members of the State Driver's Education Council shall expire as follows:
- 28 (1) 6 members in 2001;
- 29 (2) 6 members in 2002; and
- 30 (3) 5 members in 2003.
- 31 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 32 October 1, 2000.
