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State Government - Procurement - Conflict of Interests

FOR the purpose of providing that an individual who assists in a selection or award 3

- made in response to a solicitation for bids or a request for proposal proposals in 4
- 5 a State procurement, or the employer of that individual, may not submit a bid or
- proposal or assist another person who submits a bid or proposal; extending this 6
- prohibition and existing prohibitions relating to conflict of interests in State 7
- 8 procurement to an individual who employs the individual who assists in the
- 9 procurement process; requiring an individual under contract with an executive
- 10 unit of State government, who assists in, influences, or otherwise affects the
- 11 formation, award, or execution of a State procurement to file a disclosure
- 12 statement containing information relating to the individual's consultants,
- 13 employer, employer's corporate structure, and employer's subsidiaries; requiring
- 14 disclosure of the clients of the individual, the individual's employer, and any
- 15 subsidiaries of the individual's employer, and the general nature of the work
- 16 performed for each elient requiring that an invitation for bids or request for proposals for the selection of a consultant who will assist in specified State

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

(a) An individual OR A PERSON THAT EMPLOYS AN INDIVIDUAL who assists
an executive unit in the drafting of specifications, an invitation for bids, [or] a
request for proposals for a procurement, or THE SELECTION OR AWARD MADE IN
RESPONSE TO AN INVITATION FOR BUS OR PEOUEST FOR PROPOSALS [a percent the percent of th

13 RESPONSE TO AN INVITATION FOR BIDS OR REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS [a person that 14 employs the individual,] may not:

15 (1) submit a bid or proposal for that procurement; or

16 (2) assist or represent another person, directly or indirectly, who is 17 submitting a bid or proposal for that procurement.

18 (b) For purposes of subsection (a) of this section, assisting in the drafting of 19 specifications, an invitation for bids, or a request for proposals for a procurement does 20 not include:

(1) providing descriptive literature such as catalogue sheets, brochures,
technical data sheets, or standard specification "samples", whether requested by an
executive agency or provided on an unsolicited basis;

24 (2) submitting written comments on a specification prepared by an 25 agency or on a solicitation for a bid or proposal when comments are solicited from two 26 or more persons as part of a request for information or a prebid or preproposal 27 process;

(3) providing specifications for a sole source procurement made in
accordance with § 13-107 of the State Finance and Procurement Article; or

33 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER CONTRACT WITH AN EXECUTIVE UNIT OF THE 34 STATE WHO ASSISTS IN, INFLUENCES, OR OTHERWISE AFFECTS THE FORMATION, 35 AWARD, OR EXECUTION OF ANY STATE CONTRACT, PURCHASE, OR SALE SHALL FILE

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A STATEMENT WITH THE ETHICS COMMISSION THAT CONTAINS THE SCHEDULES
 DISCLOSING THE INFORMATION AND INTERESTS SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION.

3 (B) THE STATEMENT SHALL INCLUDE A SCHEDULE LISTING:

4 (1) ALL CURRENT PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SECTOR CLIENTS FROM WHOM
5 THE CONSULTANT HAS RECEIVED A FEE FOR SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH
6 CONTRACT ACTIVITIES OR OTHER AREAS REGULATED BY THE EXECUTIVE UNIT;

7 (2) THE GENERAL NATURE OF THE WORK PERFORMED FOR EACH OF 8 THE CLIENTS LISTED; AND

9 (3) ANY SUBCONSULTANT WHO ASSISTED IN THE PERFORMING OF THE
10 SERVICES, ACCOMPANIED BY A SEPARATE SCHEDULE MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS
11 OF ITEMS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION WITH RESPECT TO THAT
12 SUBCONSULTANT.

13 (C) IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS EMPLOYED BY A CORPORATION OR IF A CLIENT
 14 LISTED IN SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS A CORPORATION, THE STATEMENT
 15 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE, FOR EACH CORPORATION:

16 (1) A SCHEDULE OF THE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AND EACH DIRECT OR
 17 INDIRECT OWNER OF ANY EQUITY SECURITY OR OTHER OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN
 18 THE CORPORATION;

19(2)A SCHEDULE OF ANY APPLICABLE PARENT CORPORATION OF THE20CORPORATION AND ALL SUBSIDIARY CORPORATIONS OF THAT PARENT21CORPORATION;

22 (3) A SCHEDULE OF ANY SUBSIDIARY CORPORATIONS OF THE 23 CORPORATION; AND

24 (4) A SCHEDULE LISTING:

25 (I) ANY CLIENTS OF THE APPLICABLE PARENT OR SUBSIDIARY
 26 CORPORATIONS THAT HAVE RECEIVED A FEE FOR SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH
 27 CONTRACT ACTIVITIES OR OTHER AREAS REGULATED BY THE EXECUTIVE UNIT; AND

28(II)THE GENERAL NATURE OF THE WORK PERFORMED FOR EACH29OF THE CLIENTS LISTED.

30 (D) IF THE CORPORATION IS A PUBLICLY TRADED CORPORATION, THE

31 DISCLOSURE UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION NEED ONLY CONTAIN THE

32 NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THOSE KNOWN TO THE CORPORATION TO BENEFICIALLY

33 OWN 5% OR MORE OF THE PUBLICLY HELD SECURITIES OF THE CORPORATION.

3 (A) EACH INVITATION FOR BIDS OR REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A

4 CONTRACT THAT WILL INVOLVE THE SELECTION OF A CONSULTANT WHO IS TO

5 ASSIST THE UNIT IN THE FORMATION, AWARD, OR EXECUTION OF ANY STATE

6 CONTRACT SHALL REQUIRE THAT A BIDDER OR OFFEROR PROVIDE TO THE UNIT AN

7 AFFIDAVIT THAT DISCLOSES ANY ACTUAL OR POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST OF

8 WHICH THE BIDDER OR OFFEROR KNOWS, OR CAN REASONABLY BE EXPECTED TO

9 KNOW, IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

10(B)THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE11AND EVALUATION OF CONFLICT OF INTERESTS UNDER THIS SECTION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2000.

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
