	(D) THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE, ON OR AFTER JANUARY 31, 1999 JANUARY 1, 2000 BUT BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2008, OF MACHINERY OR FOLIPMENT:

- 1 (1) THAT ENABLES A TELEVISION OR RADIO STATION TO ORIGINATE 2 AND BROADCAST OR TO RECEIVE AND BROADCAST DIGITAL SIGNALS; AND
