5 investigating an alleged violation of the laws relating to the licensure and
6 regulation of physicians.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health Occupations**

15 14-205.

16 (a) (2) The Board [on receipt of a written and signed complaint] may
17 investigate an alleged violation of this title.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2000.
