CHAPTER 628

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Brentwood Veterans**  
3 **Memorial Park**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$80,000~~  
5 \$60,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of  
6 Brentwood for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for  
7 disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and  
8 sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
10 MARYLAND, That:

11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on  
12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince  
13 George's County - Brentwood Veterans Memorial Park Loan of 2000 in the total  
14 principal amount of ~~\$80,000~~ \$60,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance,  
15 sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the  
16 Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117  
17 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of  
18 the Code.

19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as  
20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under  
21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer  
23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and  
24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then  
25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

1 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable  
2 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of  
3 Brentwood for the repair, reconstruction, renovation, and capital equipping of an  
4 existing park dedicated to veterans of all wars, located in Brentwood, Prince George's  
5 County, Maryland.

6 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in  
7 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and  
8 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years  
9 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 June 1, 2000.
