CHAPTER 685

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Academic Facilities Bonding Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the bonding authority for the University System of
4 Maryland; approving certain projects for the acquisition, development, and
5 improvement of certain academic facilities for the University System of
6 Maryland; approving the issuance of bonds by the University System of
7 Maryland for financing the projects.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 19-102.

17 (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, the aggregate
18 principal amount of bonds outstanding and the present value of capital lease
19 payments, less the amount of any reserve fund or sinking fund requirement
20 established for the bonds or capital leases, may not exceed, as of the date of issue of
21 the bonds, the following:

- 1 (i) [\$750,000,000] \$850,000,000 for the University System of
 2 Maryland;
- 3 (ii) \$65,000,000 for Morgan State University;
- 4 (iii) \$45,000,000 for St. Mary's College of Maryland; and
- 5 (iv) \$15,000,000 for Baltimore City Community College.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

7 (1) In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the
 8 following projects is approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University
 9 System of Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of
 10 \$13,700,000 for the purposes of financing and refinancing the costs of these projects:

11 (A) University System of Maryland College Park (Prince George's
 12 County)

- 13 (i) Engineering and Applied Sciences Building: Construction
- 14 (ii) Hornbake and McKeldin Libraries: Renovation
- 15 (iii) Key and Taliaferro Halls: Renovation

16 (2) In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the
 17 following capital facilities renewal projects is hereby approved as a project for an
 18 academic facility, and the University System of Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver
 19 bonds in the principal amount of \$11,300,000 for the purposes of financing and
 20 refinancing the costs of these projects:

10 (3) The bonds issued under the authority of this Act do not create or
11 constitute any indebtedness or obligation of the State or of any political subdivision
12 thereof except the University System of Maryland, and the bonds shall so state on
13 their face. The bonds do not constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General
14 Assembly of Maryland or pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning
15 of Article III, Section 34 of the Constitution of Maryland.

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 2000.
