Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland

This bill establishes an 11-member Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland to review the current State and local tax credits that are available to individuals and businesses that provide economic development in Maryland. The task force is required to evaluate: (1) the effectiveness of these credits in providing additional economic development and growth for the State; (2) the fiscal effects of these credits for both State and local revenues; and (3) the application and certification processes of State agencies administering the tax credits.

The task force is required to report to the Senate Budget and Taxation and House Ways and Means Committees on or before December 15, 2000. The Department of Business and Economic Development and the Comptroller's Office are required to provide staff support to the task force. The task force terminates on December 31, 2000.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary
