Appropriations

Correctional Employees' Bill of Rights

This bill establishes procedures for investigations or interrogations of State and local correctional employees. The bill establishes guidelines for the conduct of an interrogation of a correctional employee by a law enforcement agency and establishes a procedure for filing a complaint alleging specified actions of brutality against a correctional employee.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. The bill's requirements could be handled with the existing budgeted resources of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.

Local Effect: Minimal. The bill's requirements could be handled with the existing budgeted resources of local government.

Small Business Effect: None.
