Ways and Means

Higher Education - Private Career Schools - Tuition and Fees

This bill permits the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) to require a private career school to publish in its catalog its schedule of tuition and fees and method of payment. MHEC may not prohibit a private career school from offering a discounted tuition or fee for a course even if the discounted amount is different from the school's published tuition and fees.
