A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Prosecutor - Annual Report - Sanctions**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Prosecutor to submit an annual report to
4 certain State officials on or before a certain day; making the State Prosecutor
5 subject to reprimand or removal from office if a certain annual report is not
6 submitted to certain State officials on or before a certain day; and generally
7 relating to the Office of the State Prosecutor.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - State Government**

16 9-1210.

17 (a) [The] ON OR BEFORE 45 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR,
18 THE State Prosecutor shall submit an annual report to the Governor, to the Attorney
19 General, and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General
20 Assembly on the activities of Office of the State Prosecutor that are not confidential.

21 (B) FAILURE TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT AS REQUIRED UNDER
22 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL SUBJECT THE STATE PROSECUTOR TO
23 REPRIMAND OR REMOVAL FROM OFFICE UNDER § 9-1213 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 2001.
