2 **Vehicle Laws - Registration Plate Covers - Distorting Characters of Vehicle**
3 **Registration Plate**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "registration plate cover" to include a
5 certain object that distorts a recorded image of any of the characters of a vehicle
6 registration plate recorded by a traffic control monitoring system; and generally
7 relating to vehicle registration plate covers.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Transportation**

16 13-411.1.

17 (a) In this section, "registration plate cover" means any tinted, colored,
18 painted, marked, CLEAR, or illuminated object that is designed to:

19 (1) [cover] COVER any of the characters of a vehicle's registration plate;
20 OR

21 (2) DISTORT A RECORDED IMAGE OF ANY OF THE CHARACTERS OF A
22 VEHICLE'S REGISTRATION PLATE RECORDED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL
23 MONITORING SYSTEM UNDER § 21-202.1 OF THIS TITLE.

24 (b) A person may not sell or offer for sale a registration plate cover.

25 (c) A person may not advertise for the purpose of promoting the sale of
26 registration plate covers.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2001.
