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- 1 [(c)](D) The Department shall administer the Program through the local 2 health departments using a grant program under which a local health department 3 makes arrangements with health care facilities to provide screening mammograms 4 and clinical breast examinations to eligible individuals. 5 [(d)](E) An individual is eligible for the Program if the individual: 6 (1) Has a family income that does not exceed 250% of the federal poverty 7 level; and 8 Does not have access to health insurance coverage that covers (2) 9 screening mammograms and clinical breast examinations for women aged 40 years 10 and older. 11 [(e)] For each fiscal year, the Governor shall include an appropriation of 12 general funds to the Program in an amount not less than the amount appropriated for 13 breast cancer screening, diagnosis, and treatment in the State budget for fiscal year 14 1999, subject to the availability of State funds. 15 [(f)] (G) The Department shall: 16 Adopt regulations necessary to implement the Program; and (1) 17 Work with all interested parties to assure that breast cancer 18 screening services are available to women at least 40 years old.
