CHAPTER 113

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Registration Plates - Transfer into an Inter Vivos Trust**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing the continued use of registration plates after the
4 transfer of the title or interest in a vehicle into a certain inter vivos trust; and
5 generally relating to the use of vehicle registration plates after a transfer into
6 an inter vivos trust.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 13-503.3.

16 (A) IF THE TITLE OR INTEREST OF AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE IS TRANSFERRED
17 INTO A WRITTEN INTER VIVOS TRUST IN WHICH THE TRANSFEROR IS THE PRIMARY
18 BENEFICIARY, THE TRANSFEREE MAY CONTINUE TO USE THE SAME REGISTRATION
19 PLATES AFTER THE TRANSFER.

20 (B) IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS THE TRANSFER SHALL BE TREATED THE SAME
21 WAY AS ANY OTHER TRANSFER BY A PRIVATE OWNER OF A REGISTERED VEHICLE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 June 1, 2001.
