CHAPTER 291

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - Student Financial Assistance - Retention of Unused**
3 **Funds**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing that certain money appropriated by the State for
5 student financial assistance that is not used in a certain fiscal year may not
6 revert to the State Treasury and may be used only for certain purposes;
7 prohibiting the use of certain money for administrative expenses; clarifying
8 language; and generally relating to the retention and use of money appropriated
9 by the State for student financial assistance.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 18-102.

3 Except as otherwise provided in this title, the provisions of this subtitle apply to
4 any scholarship, grant, or loan awarded under this title.

5 18-107.

6 (a) Each year, money for each award program under this title shall be
7 included in the State budget.

8 (b) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, money appropriated under
9 this [section] TITLE that is not used by the end of the fiscal year [reverts] MAY NOT
10 REVERT to the State Treasury.

11 (2) ALL MONEY RETAINED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
12 SHALL BE USED TO MAKE AWARDS TO STUDENTS DURING SUBSEQUENT FISCAL
13 YEARS AS PROVIDED IN §§ 18-301, 18-706(D), 18-1401, AND 18-1501 OF THIS TITLE AND
14 § 13-613(D)(1) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE AND MAY NOT BE USED FOR
15 ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 2001.
