CHAPTER 344

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Scooters and In-Line Roller Skating Skates - Protective Helmets and**
3 **Headgear**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting ~~a person~~ an individual under a certain age from
5 riding in certain places on certain scooters or in-line skates unless the ~~person~~
6 individual wears a helmet ~~or protective headgear~~ that meets or exceeds certain
7 standards; providing for the issuance of a certain warning; and generally
8 relating to the ~~use~~ operation of scooters or in-line skates ~~by certain persons~~.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY NOT RIDE ON A
20 SCOOTER OR ON IN-LINE SKATES ON ANY HIGHWAY, BICYCLE WAY, SIDEWALK, OR
21 OTHER PROPERTY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC OR USED BY THE PUBLIC FOR PEDESTRIAN
22 OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, UNLESS THE PERSON INDIVIDUAL IS WEARING A HELMET
23 THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE STANDARDS OF THE AMERICAN NATIONAL
24 STANDARDS INSTITUTE, THE SNELL MEMORIAL FOUNDATION'S STANDARD, OR THE
25 STANDARDS OF FOUNDATION, OR THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF TESTING AND
26 MEASUREMENTS FOR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR FOR USE IN BICYCLING OR IN-LINE
27 SKATING.

29 WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION
30 AND PROVIDES EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS ABOUT HELMET USE.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
