CHAPTER 353

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Procurement - State Leasing of Real Property - Notice of Proposed**
3 **Leases**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the requirements under which the State may execute a
5 lease of real property; altering the notice required prior to the execution of
6 certain leases; and generally relating to State leasing of real property.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

15 4-319.

16 (a) This section applies to any lease of property by the State.

17 (b) (1) The Department shall give written notice of each proposed initial
18 lease of property to:

1 (i) the governing body of each political subdivision in which the
2 property is located; and

3 (ii) each member of the General Assembly in whose legislative
4 district the property is located.

5 (2) If the notice given under paragraph (1) of this subsection is for at
6 least 2 proposed sites from which 1 site is to be selected, before any site is finally
7 selected, the Department shall give written notice of the site that has been proposed
8 for final selection.

9 [(3) The provisions of this section concerning notice, response, and
10 execution apply to any notice, including a 2nd or later notice issued under paragraph
11 (2) of this subsection.]

12 (c) Within 30 days after receiving [any] notice under subsection [(b)] (B)(1) of
13 this section, the governing body or the member of the General Assembly may submit
14 written comments to the Department.

15 (d) A lease for a site may not be executed until 31 days after the day that
16 notice is received under subsection [(b)] (B)(1) of this section.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2001.
