2                                   **Workers' Compensation - Credit Against Payment of Permanent Partial**  
3                                   **Disability Awards After Appeal**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that, if an award of permanent partial disability  
5 workers' compensation is reversed or modified by a court on appeal, the  
6 payment of the award must be subject to a credit for any compensation  
7 previously awarded and paid.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15                                   **Article - Labor and Employment**

16 9-633.

17 IF AN AWARD OF PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY COMPENSATION IS  
18 REVERSED OR MODIFIED BY A COURT ON APPEAL, THE PAYMENT OF ANY NEW  
19 COMPENSATION AWARDED SHALL BE:

20                   (1) SUBJECT TO A CREDIT FOR COMPENSATION PREVIOUSLY AWARDED  
21 AND PAID; AND

1 (2) OTHERWISE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PART IV OF THIS  
2 SUBTITLE.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 2001.
