Family Law - Marriage License - Social Security Number of Applicants

This bill requires a marriage license to include the Social Security number of each party to be married.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not significantly impact governmental operations or finances. Marriage licenses and application forms are already required to contain spaces for Social Security numbers for those who voluntarily disclose them.

Current Law: It is optional for individuals to provide their Social Security numbers for inclusion on a marriage license.
